Students not passing their courses in the 2nd semester must be within 2 credits of graduating to participate in the graduation ceremony. Any senior involved with vandalism, destruction of property, or egregious behavior may not be allowed to participate as well.

Fines, etc.

Seniors are required to pay any outstanding fines, etc. by May 20th. Seniors who do not pay their fines are not allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony. Please have your graduate verify with Kim in the office on the status of anything outstanding.

Graduation Practice (MAC gym)

Graduation practice is scheduled in the MAC gym from 10:46 to 11:45 (right after 3rd hour) on Friday, May 24th. Seniors who plan to participate in the graduation program on May 24th <u>must</u> participate in this practice session.

Ticket Process

We will again have a ticketing process for our graduate's family and friends. Each graduate will be given **ten tickets** to hand to those they want in attendance. Your tickets will be sent out in mid-May. The MAC doors will open at 6:00PM for families with the processional beginning at 7:00 p.m.

Formal Pictures (Middle School Gym)

Graduates will have formal photos taken <u>prior</u> to the commencement on May 24th in our Middle School Gym. We will want graduates that are in band or choir to arrive at 5:30pm; all other graduates with last names beginning with letters A-L should arrive at 6:00pm; and graduates with last names M-Z should arrive at 6:15pm.
