The 3rd Grade MCA results were disappointing in 2022. We had a sense that this grade would be at risk based upon the experience covid created for their first few years in public schools and their FAST data from primary grades. At the same time, we kept our goals as high as they have historically been and tried to reach them. Overall, spring of 2022 was an excellent MCA year for Pioneer Elementary School and this particular Grade 3 was the outlier relative to how the other Grades performed.

We are investing in the LETRS training and instruction for the 2022-23 school year and for years to follow. We are hoping this will have an impact on our Grade 3 Literacy Goals.

Overall we are pleased with the fact that we achieved this goal of reducing the achievement gap for our largest group of at-risk learners. Traditionally, we take pride in serving all students equitably and strive for no distinctions among student groups.

Interestingly in evaluating our data, it could be noted that Two Grade Levels (Grade 3 and Grade 8) accounted for the vast majority of that gap. In every other grade, the gap ranged from 8% at the most to a couple grades where there was no gap at all.

Pierz middle school teachers were excited to work directly with Onamia Schools (the RIS School) to create more opportunities for educational and integration experiences for our students. We implemented some very enlightening events designed to both teach as well as motivate student interaction. Covid mitigation limited some of those opportunities over the course of the 3 year project. We tried again in 2022. That particular experience ran into some challenges more related to student behaviors. It is our intention to continue. Our school is also working to develop more educational opportunities and is starting our own American Indian Parent Advisory Council.
